POSITION OVERVIEW

Our Event Bartender is more than someone who pours drinks. You set the tone for the evening. During the compressed energy of pre-show and intermission, you're fast, friendly, and in control — making every patron feel like they've got time for one more before the lights go down.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Prepare and serve beer, wine, and non-alcoholic beverages during pre-show and intermission service windows
- Maintain a clean, organized, and fully stocked bar area before, during, and after each performance
- Monitor patron alcohol consumption and adhere to responsible service standards
- Check identification as required by Florida law
- Coordinate with the House Manager and front-of-house team on timing and service needs
- Stock bar prior to opening and break down and clean the bar area following each performance

QUALIFICATIONS

- Prior bartending or beverage service experience preferred
- Florida Safe Serve certification (or willingness to obtain prior to first shift)
- Comfortable working in fast, high-volume bursts in a public-facing environment
- Professional, personable, and calm under pressure
- Availability for evening and weekend performances
